    - Workshops, Service and Personal
  4. List what we've done a good job with.
    - Good job with subcommittees
    - H&I and PR subcommittees are doing fantastic
  5. Plan ways to be more effective in carrying the message
    - Need more online mentoring for new trusted servants
    - Trusted servants should review EASC bylaws for job descriptions of each trusted servant position.
    - Literature committee needs more workers (support)
    - Outreach needs support
    - Organize training/mentoring workshops at campouts/conventions.
    - GSR orientation workshops
