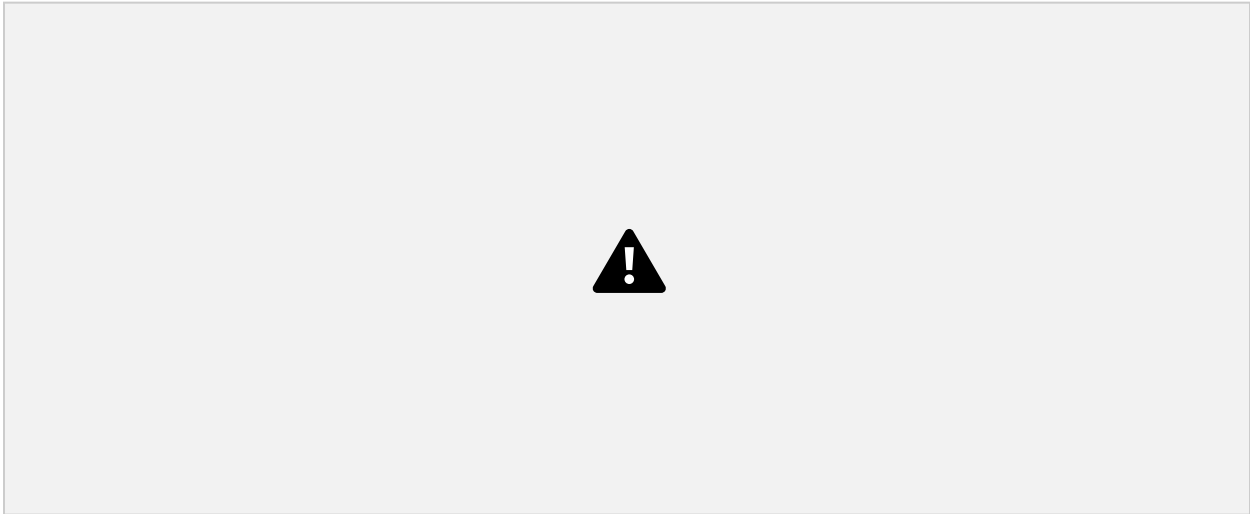

Group discussion: Thomas from Blind Faith meeting, shared with the group the federal law about service animals being allowed at meetings, they should be with the disabled individual and on a leash. Stating that the only reason they cannot stay in a building is if it's at a church or private club where you pay regular fees. The only reason they can be asked to leave a meeting is if the service animal is not house broken and/or the disabled individual cannot handle the animal. An individual's right to use service dogs is protected under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
